# STATUTORY NOTIFICATIONS/UPDATES

## ESIC - IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CODE ON SOCIAL SECURITY, 2020.

The Employees' State Insurance Corporation vide File No. N-11011/2/2025-BFT-II dated 28.11.2025 notifies that the Code on Social Security, 2020 has brought in certain modification in the definitions of "dependent" and "family" from the previous definition given under the ESI Act, 1948. As per the revised provisions, under sub-clause (c) of Section 2(24) a widower and a grandparent have now been included under the definition of "dependant" and are therefore entitled for Dependent Benefit. Similarly, Father-in-law and mother-in-law of a woman employee have been included under the definition of "family" at sub-clause (e) of Section 2(33) and are entitled for Medical Benefit. It is, therefore, requested that the revised definitions of "dependant" and "family" as provided in the Code on Social Security, 2020, may be duly considered while extending the relevant benefits to eligible persons.

## **PIB HEADQUARTERS - NEW LABOUR CODES EMPOWER WOMEN WITH GREATER SAFETY, EQUALITY, AND WORKPLACE FLEXIBILITY.**

The Press Information Bureau vide Press Release dated 27.11.2025 clarified that the new labour codes empower women with greater safety, equality and workplace flexibility. The Labour Codes strengthen women's roles in workplaces through greater representation in grievance and advisory bodies. Enhanced maternity support includes 26 weeks' leave, simplified certification, nursing breaks and mandatory crèche facilities. Women receive added flexibility through work-from-home options after maternity leave, wherever feasible. The Codes ensure gender parity with strict prohibition of discrimination and guarantee of equal pay for equal work.

The Ministry of Labour and Employment vide G.S.R. 868(E) dated 26.11.2025 notified the Draft Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions (Oil Mines) Regulations, 2022, which the Central Government proposes to make in exercise of powers conferred by Section 136 of the Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020, as required by sub-section (1) of section 134, for information of all persons likely to be affected thereby and notice is hereby given that the said draft notification will be taken into consideration after the expiry of a period of 45 days from the date on which the copies of the Official Gazette in which this notification is published are made available to the public.

The Press Information Bureau Headquarters vide Press Release dated 22.11.2025 notified the key takeaways from the implementation of Code on Social Security, 2020. The code aims towards universal and inclusive social protection, merging nine existing Social Security Acts into one framework, ensuring universal social protection for organized, unorganized, gig and platform workers. It extends EPFO and ESIC coverage nationwide, bringing more establishments and workers under social security benefits; recognizes Gig and Platform workers for the first time and establishes a Social Security Fund for their welfare.

The Press Information Bureau Headquarters vide Press Release dated 22.11.2025 notified the key takeaways from the implementation of Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions (OSH) Code, 2020. The Code replaces 13 Central labour Laws by a single comprehensive legislation, thereby reducing multiplicity and bringing uniformity across industries and States/UTs. The Code balances the twin objectives of safeguarding worker rights and safe working conditions and creating a business-friendly regulatory environment spur economic growth and employment thereby, making India's labour market more efficient, fair, and future-ready.

**PIB HEADQUARTERS - CODE ON WAGES, 2019 SAFEGUARDS WORKERS, INDUCES GROWTH, EMPOWERS WOMEN & ENHANCES EMPLOYMENT.**

The Press Information Bureau Headquarters vide Press Release dated 23.11.2025 notified the key takeaways from the implementation of Code on Wages, 2019. This Code amalgamated 4 wages and payment related labour laws viz. The Payment of Wages Act, 1936, The Minimum Wages Act, 1948, the Payment of Bonus Act, 1965 and the Equal Remuneration Act, 1976. Section 5 of the Code on Wages, 2019 establishes a statutory right to minimum wages for all employees, extending its coverage to every sector, both organised and unorganised. Earlier, the minimum wages applied only to scheduled employments, covering roughly 30% of the workforce.

## **PIB HEADQUARTERS - INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS CODE, 2020: PROMOTING HARMONY AND EASE OF DOING BUSINESS.**

The Press Information Bureau Headquarters vide Press Release dated 23.11.2025 notified the key takeaways from the implementation of Industrial Relations Code, 2020. This code consolidates three existing laws viz. i.e. Industrial Disputes Act, 1947, Trade Unions Act, 1926 and Industrial Employment (Standing Orders) Act, 1946. With the introduction of this Code, the number of rules has been reduced from 105 to 51, number of forms from 37 to 18 and number of registers from 3 to zero, thereby reducing the overall compliance burden to spur employment.

During the transition, the relevant provisions of the existing labour Acts and their respective rules, regulations, notifications, standards, schemes, etc. will continue to remain in force.

The Employees Provident Fund Organization vide File No. LC-12011(15)/19/2021-LEGAL(E-34577)/13862 dated 19.11.2025 issued a Notification regarding the Amendments in Sections 14AC and 14B of the EPF and MP Act, 1952 – Notification No. S.O. 4920(E) dated 29.10.2025. The amended provisions of Section 14AC and 14B of the said Act, 1952 shall come into force from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette, i.e., 29th October 2025. As per the Notification dated 29.10.2025, the Central Government hereby authorizes that the powers vested in the Central Provident Fund Commissioner under the provisions of sections 14AC and 14B shall also be exercisable within each of the regions specified in the Schedule in the Notification.

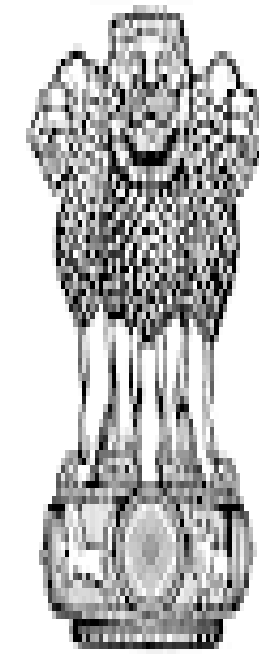

# IMPORTANT JUDGEMENTS

## HIGH COURT CANNOT ENLARGE THE LIMITATION BEYOND THE PERIOD STATUTORILY PROVIDED.

M/s. Vigil Security Bureau Pvt Ltd. v. The Regional Provident Fund Commissioner, 2025 LLR 1267 (MADRAS HIGH COURT).

**Facts of the Case:** In this case, a writ petition was filed challenging the order dated 11-08-2023 of the respondent rejecting the petitioner's appeal on the ground of delay. The Regional Provident Fund Commissioner, Chennai Region ordered to recover Rs. 25,42,666/- under section 7A of the Act and that was challenged by the petitioner in the EPF Tribunal Delhi on 24-09-2015. The appeal was transferred to respondent Tribunal Chennai and meanwhile, the petitioner filed writ petition in the year 2022 and the matter was disposed off in 20-09-2022 by giving liberty to petitioner to pursue the extension application and ordered the Tribunal to decide the matter based on merits.



# IMPORTANT JUDGEMENTS

The Counsel for respondent submitted that there is lack of direction by the Court to dispose the matter and submitted that there cannot be any extension of the period of limitation beyond statutory period prescribed under the Act based on the judgement of SC in CCT v. Glaxo Smith Kline Consumer Health Care Ltd(2020) 19 SCC 681 and the writ shall be dismissed.

The petitioner approached the Court by the writ petition in the year 2022 to condone the delay of 465 days including the statutory period of 120 days by a prayer of Mandamus to direct the respondent. The Court held that, though the petitioner has moved the writ petition, to condone the delay of 460 days it is yet to be disposed by the court and it is open to the petitioner to pursue the said application before the tribunal. The tribunal have the authority over the matter to decide it within 60 days of receipt of the copy of order.

# IMPORTANT JUDGEMENTS

## Issue of the Case:

The issue of the case is such that whether the Court has the power to enlarge the limitation beyond the statutory time frame prescribed?

## Judgement of the Case:

The learned counsel for petitioner lastly submitted that, they seek permission to pay the balance of Rs. 15,40,340/- in instalments and such be permitted to be paid in 15 instalments due to economic recession and impact on the business of the petitioner due to foreclosures. And based on all of it, the Court directed to pay the balance in 10 monthly instalments and pay the 1st instalment on or before 05 10-2025. Rest of the 9 instalments on the 5th of every succeeding English calendar month. It was clear with this case that the respondents are at liberty to take action necessary for recovery of the balance amount as per the letters of law.

# IMPORTANT JUDGEMENTS

**PERIOD OF LIMITATION IS TO BE CALCULATED FROM THE DATE OF THE KNOWLEDGE OF THE ORDER.**

**M/s. Ace Engineers v. Assistant Provident Fund Commissioner & Anr. 2025 LLR 1274 (MADRAS HIGH COURT).**

**Facts of the Case:** In this case, the writ petition has been filed challenging the order passed by Appellate Authority under the Employees' Provident Fund and Miscellaneous Provisions Act based on notice not being allegedly served to the petitioner in respect of the proceedings under section 7(A) of the Act and that they claimed to have knowledge about the order passed by the Authority dated 07 11-2017, only on 07-12-2020. This was followed by the filing of the appeal before the Authority. But the Appellant authority dismissed the matter even before considering the facts and merits of the case and this led to the present petition.



# IMPORTANT JUDGEMENTS

The respondent submitted that, petitioner belatedly filed the appeal before the Authority. And it was found in the enquiry that the petitioner managed to return the notice and refused to accept the same and it was later served to an employee. To according to the respondent, the petitioner had the knowledge about the notice since, they submitted letter on 04-12-2020 and paid the quantum amount fixed by the Authority fixed under section 7(A) of the Act.

The submission by the petitioner based on certain precedents directed the issue in a way that, the parties who sought remedies shall be communicated of any order passed and the period of Limitation starts when such order is communicated and when the party becomes aware of it by means of pronouncement or through any other circumstance of reasonable ground.

**Issues of the Case:** Whether Court shall take into consideration the date of knowledge or date of passing of order to calculate the period of limitation?

# IMPORTANT JUDGEMENTS

## Judgement of the Case:

Lastly the Court decided that the matter be remanded back to the Appellant Authority for fresh consideration based on merits and limitations of the case. Further, it was directed to dispose the appeal within 2 months from the receipt of a copy of order.
